Where can I find magazine and journal articles on my topic?

- Beneath the “Ask Us” heading in the middle of the library home page, click on “How to Find – Articles.” This will give you general information on several pathways for locating journal articles. It will also provide you with links to these databases. You can choose a particular database to search depending on your need. Academic Search Premier is a general EBSCO database you may have used before.

Can I access the library article databases from my residence hall?

- Yes, most of the databases are available any where on campus

Can I access the library article databases off campus?

- Yes, most of the databases are available off campus. Just access the database the same way you would if you were on campus. You will be prompted for your name and barcode information.

Computer Availability

- There are student-use computers located on the 3rd (Main Entry) Floor, in the Atrium Area on the 2nd Floor, and in the e-Classroom on the 1st Floor. All the computers on the 2nd Floor as well as the Macs on the 3rd (Main Entry) Floor have word processing software. All computers play DVDs and CDs. Please ask for headphones at the Circulation Desk. There are also data ports located throughout the library for laptop connections to the campus network. Wireless access is also available.
- The reference desk has 5 laptops available for 2 hour check-out for library use only.

Photocopying procedures:

- There are 3 copiers on the 2nd Floor. There is also one in the Reference area on the 3rd (Main Entry) Floor. All copiers take a copy card, although some also take cash. Copy cards are available for purchase at the Circulation Desk. They cost \$4.00 for 100 copies. Cash copies are 10 cents a piece.
